

YELLOWKNIFE CURLING CLUB

CONSTITUTION

- Article 1: The name of the Organization shall be the Yellowknife Curling Club, hereinafter known as “The Club”.
- Article 2: The Objectives of The Club shall be:
- (a) To promote the game of curling and participation in the game.
 - (b) To affiliate and cooperate with other curling clubs and sport organizations or societies formed for the purposes set out in paragraph 2 (a) above or any similar purposes.
- Article 3: The office and operations of The Club are located in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories.
- Article 4: In the event that The Club should, at any time, be wound up or dissolved, the remaining assets, after payments of all debts and liabilities, shall be turned over to a recognized curling organization with objectives similar to those of The Club or if this cannot be done, to another recognized sport organization within Yellowknife or elsewhere in the Northwest Territories as directed by the members.
- Article 5: The Club shall carry out it’s objectives without purpose of financial gain for it’s members and shall use any profits or *accretions* to The Club for promoting its objectives.
- Article 6: The Club shall not remunerate any director or officer for being or acting as a director or officer, but may reimburse a director or officer for all expenses necessarily and reasonably incurred while engaged in the affairs of The Club.
- Article 7: Articles 4,5 and 6 of this Constitution are unalterable in accordance with the Northwest Territories Societies Act.
